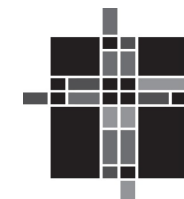

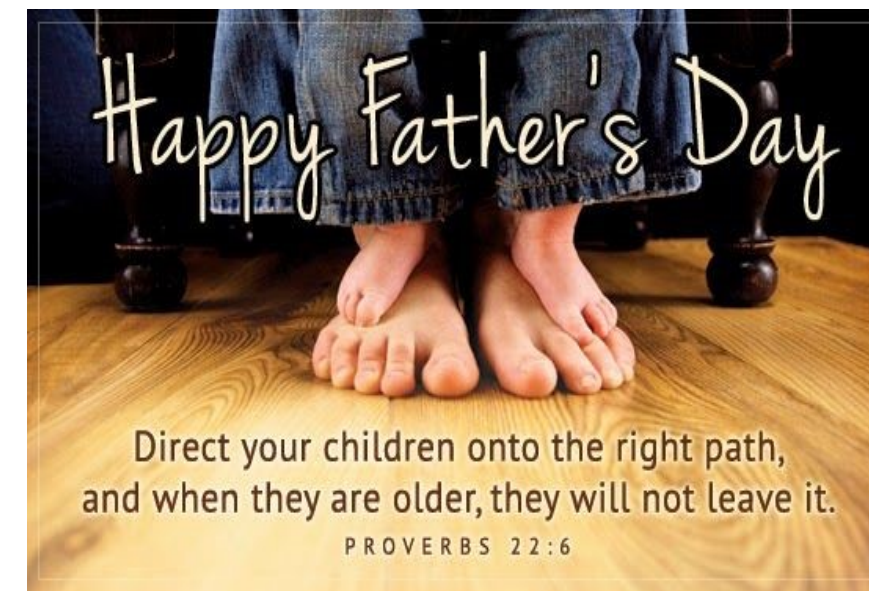

Acts 1:8

My Daddy had surgery this week at Magnolia Hospital in Corinth. Many of you prayed for him and sent me texts or called. We greatly appreciate your prayers and concern during this time. The surgery was successful, and he is at home recouping now.



Daddy wanted all of his children there, as he was anxious about the surgery. This surgery is normally a routine outpatient surgery, but sometimes there are complications.

As I walked into the pre-op holding room, my Daddy grabbed my hand and squeezed it, and he told me he loved me and said everything is going to be ok. He held on to my hand for what seemed like hours. He rubbed and patted my hand and we talked, reminisced, and we laughed. I know my Daddy loves me. This is his love language. He wanted his children and family with him, because he loves us. God wants to love on us and spend time with us as well.

As we celebrate Father's day this Sunday, I am reminded of this verse in I John: "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him." I John 3:1
